The board voted to finish the year with the following procedures in place:

- For the remainder of the year, wearing a mask will be a recommendation but not a requirement. The Lawrence County School District will follow the directive of the governor and masks will no longer be a requirement for our students and staff. We ask that all parents, students, and staff make an informed decision if they intend to continue wearing a mask or not. In addition, we ask that everyone respect others decision and not criticize others for wearing or not wearing a mask.
- The Lawrence County School District will continue to make the safety and well-being of our students a priority. Social distancing will still be practiced when possible, sterilization and deep cleaning in the buildings will continue, and large gatherings will be avoided.
